Annotations and Methodology: The above table represents the number and percent of high school graduates that were 'ever enrolled' during the first fall semester after high school graduation at the college most closely associated with each feeder high school. These data are based on each student's high school of origin and graduation date taken from the student's admissions application. The number of high school graduates comes from CBEDS data reported to the California Dept of Ed annually. This list is separated into two pages. The first page shows the primary feeder high schools with the total Enrollment Yield for each college over the five-year period. Additional enrollment data are shown for 23 high schools in our extended service area including small, rural high schools, and continuation/adult high schools (noted with an asterisk). In some cases, data from CBEDS are missing. These are indicated with '--' in the table to avoid errors with sums and percents.
