1. Call to Order & Introductions	Meeting was called to order at 10:09 a.m.

3. Approval of Summary Minutes: 10-22-19	No approval of the meeting minutes- did not meet quorum.
4. Project Status Report Measure G & J- Randall Rowles	 A. Bakersfield College/Delano Center, B. Cerro Coso Community College, C. Porterville College, D. District Office:
	Mr. Randall Rowles presented a summary Power Point report on the District Measure G SRID, spending summary for October 20, 2020 that is attached hereto and incorporated herein. Spending Summary included the original Measure G budget of \$180,000,000. Interest and other revenues are \$26,121.645. Total SRID Funds are \$206,121,645. Total Funds spent to date are \$195,889,616. Total funds available for use \$8,910,413. A bar graph showed SRID Expenditures by College, including District Office of \$26,905,057.75, Porterville College of \$28,479,156.73, Cerro Coso Community College of \$40,704,856.99, and Bakersfield College of \$99,800,544.37 totaling \$195,889,616. The next slide shows a total of \$8,910,413 of unspent funds.

5. Measure J Funding Analysis and Issuance of Series C and BAN Bonds: Thomas J. Burke, Chancellor	In addition, Randall Rowles reported on the District Measure J spending summary for October 20, 2020. Spending summary included the original Measure J budget of \$502,820,956. Interest and other revenues are \$3,296,501. Total Measure J funds are \$506117,457. Total Measure J funds spent to date are \$82,546,158. A bar graph showed expenditures by College including District Office of \$2,129,069.56, Porterville College \$2,765,927.90, Cerro Coso Community College \$15,101,570.95, and Bakersfield College \$62,549,589.93, totaling \$82,546,158. Total of Measure J unspent funds are \$346,608,400. Mr. Burke reported the next issuance of notes and bonds went to market today 10-20-2020. 64K for Measure J were issued. Interest cost is 2.47% over life of the bond. BANS-issued with some bond anticipation. Notes to mature in 2023 at 1.09%. Reason of the BANS- Prop 39 limits 25k to every 100k. With the anticipation of decline in oil, BANS were issued to keep up with the cashflow. <u>Discussion:</u> Jesse Frederick asked if the District anticipated any changes to the bond requirements? Tom Burke responded: We need to see what happens with oil. Tom offered to speak with the Kern Taxpayers Association about the requirements and effects of forthcoming decline.
