BP 4400 Community Services Programs

Education Code Section 78300;
Title 5 Sections 55002 and 55160 subdivision (b)

Community Services offerings are established and maintained in civic, vocational, literacy, health, family and consumer sciences, technical and general education programs, including, but not limited to, classes in the fields of music, drama, art, handicraft, science, literature, nature study, nature contacting, aquatic sports and athletics.

Community Services offerings are designed to provide instruction and to contribute to the physical, mental, moral, economic, or civic development of the individuals or groups enrolled in them.

Offerings are open for admission to adults and of those minors as in the judgment of the Board of Trustees may profit.

General Fund moneys are not expended to establish an maintain Community Service offerings.

Students enrolled in community service offerings may be charged a fee not to exceed the cost of maintaining community service classes, or classes may be provided for remuneration by contract, or with contributions or donations of individuals or groups.
