Note: This policy is legally required.

The District Chancellor or designee, shall establish procedures that assure appropriate articulation of the District's educational programs with proximate high schools and baccalaureate institutions.

The procedures may also support articulation with institutions, including other community colleges and those not geographically proximate but that are appropriate and advantageous for partnership with the District.

The development of a plan for articulation of courses and programs shall be the responsibility of the College President or designee in consultation with the Academic Senate and include the courses to be approved and the awarding of credit with procedures developed by the Curriculum Committee and the faculty in the appropriate discipline.
