Re: RFP #DO250409- NOTICE OF ELIGIBLITY/NON-ELIGIBILITY FOR AWARD

The re-scoring of the Kern region's California Jobs First Catalyst Grant applications has now been completed by the Kern Coalition members. A total of 45 proposals from 43 applicants requesting a total of \$40,573,129.19 were evaluated.

Of these, sixteen (16) applications scoring a minimum of 58 points or more of the 115 points available under the scoring matrix were deemed eligible for funding. Eligible application requests totaled \$13,036,443.93 in awards. The total amount available for award in this Catalyst Grant funding round is \$9 million dollars.

Accordingly, eligibility for funding is not a guarantee that the amount of funds requested will be awarded, or that any amount will be awarded. All eligible funding requests will be proportionately reduced to come within the \$9 million funding limit. Funding will further be subject to and conditioned upon an eligible applicant and the KCCD Grants Office reaching agreement on the terms and conditions of a Sub-awardee MOU and approval of the same by the KCCD Board of Trustees.

Beginning next week, the KCCD Grants Office will begin contacting eligible applicants to schedule a meeting to review the proposed funding amounts as well as the MOU terms, compliance requirements, reporting expectations, and deliverables. The Kern Coalition wishes to thank all of the applicants for their interest and commitment to advancing economic development in Kern County. We encourage your continued engagement as the Implementation Phase begins, during which future statewide funding opportunities may become available.
