## Current Fall 2017 Enrollment Update

Bakersfield College headcount is up (7.2%), enrollments are up (4.8%), FTES is up (6.4%), and the number of sections offered has also increased compared to this time last year (8.8%).

Meanwhile, headcount is up in KCCD (8.2%), enrollments are up (5.6%), FTES is up (6.3%), and the number of sections offered has also increased (6.2%).

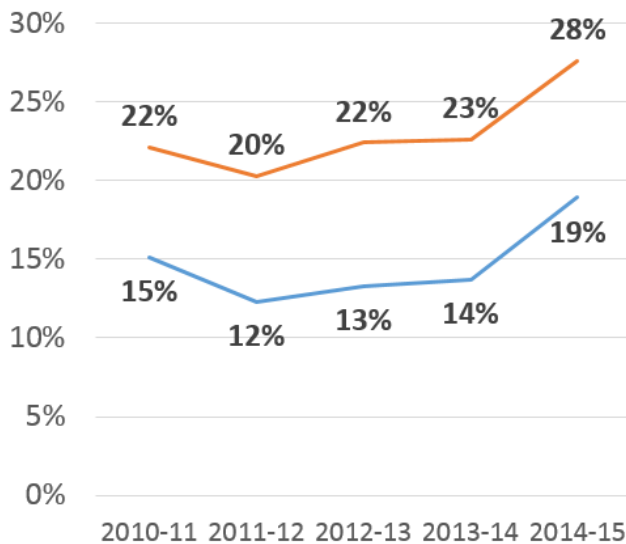

## Increasing Transfer Math and English Completion

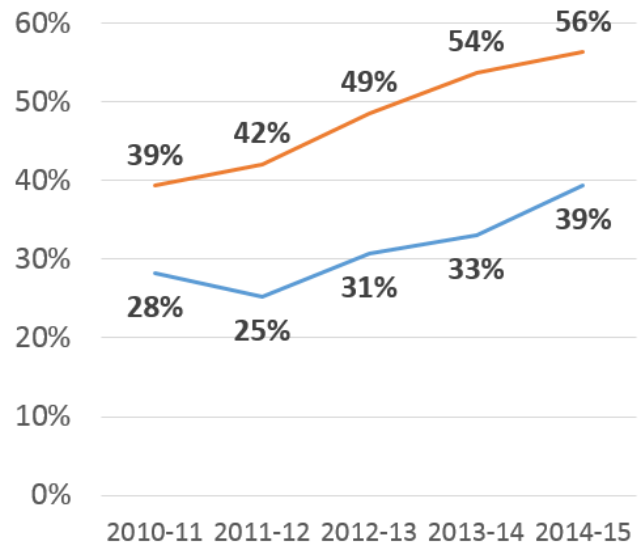
The displayed graphs show the 5 year trend in completion of transfer level English or Math in their programs. The two year relative increase for transfer level math was 27% and for transfer level English 39%.

In addition to the charts, BC's institutional researcher mentioned that ADT recipients are graduating with significantly fewer units than students in the traditional AA/AS programs.

## Bakersfield College Accreditation Update

Bakersfield College is in full gear developing our institutional self-evaluation report (ISER) and the quality focused essay (QFE). We have a large steering committee including the co-chairs of our Accreditation and Institutional Quality (AIQ) Committee<sup>1</sup>, Jessica Wojtysiak and Bill Moseley, along with the entire membership of AIQ, which has been expanded to incorporate more of the constituent groups of Bakersfield College: now representing administration, classified, faculty and students.

Our AIQ Committee is not an ad hoc committee, but a standing committee embedded into our institutional structure and it serves a core role in the decision-making process regarding improving institutional effectiveness at BC. This standing committee provides oversight of the accreditation process by ensuring that accreditation is an on-going and integrated process in the evaluation of institutional effectiveness.

The accreditation standards are embedded within the 12 campus wide committees and the development of the self evaluation which occurs in a seven year cycle utilized these existing committee structures. This is an indication of the colleges systematic approach to assuring quality and continuous improvement which are the principals of accreditation. Under the purview of AIQ, the coordination of the ISER report is being co-chaired by Jason Stratton and Liz Rozell.

During the spring semester of 2017, the writing leads were developing drafts for the self evaluation. Over 90% of the teams have submitted a first ISER draft for their team. This summer, accreditation planning has continued with a successful norming evaluation meeting of some of these drafts and preparations for an Accreditation Writing Institute to be held for the standard team leads on August 9, 2017.
