Summer/Fall 2018 Enrollment Update

The May 30^{th} report from the District Research Office shows, student headcount for Summer 2018 has increased by 13.6% and current FTES is 1,706 (+11%) compared to this point-in-time last year. The Fall headcount increased 5.7% and FTES is 5721 (+8%). We increased the number of active sections for both terms this year by 110 for summer and 101 for fall.


Many of you have worked alongside Norma during the

Data snippet from our ISER

Attainment of a college degree or credential is critical to economic advancement of individuals in our community. That being said, the educational background of individuals in BC's service area is diverse. As shown in the figure below, within Bakersfield's city limits, attainment of a college degree is markedly lower than the average for all of California (29% vs. 38%). However, degree attainment in the surrounding rural areas (Delano, South West, and North West cluster) is a fraction of the statewide average (9% vs. 38%), underscoring the critical urgency of BC's targeted focus on rural Kern.
