Dear Colleagues,

On behalf of the Transfer Taskforce, I invite you to the unveiling of Finish in 4, a collaboration between BC and CSUB on Tuesday, May 8th at 9:00AM in the Fireside Room. The Finish in 4 initiative is a joint effort to encourage students in Kern County to complete their transfer and baccalaureate degrees in 4 years from start to finish!

Over the last 4 years BC has been working with KHSD and CSUB to overcome institutional barriers and ease the transition for students as they pass from one educational sector to the next. This past year the Transfer Taskforce has particularly focused on clarifying the transfer pathways to baccalaureate completion.

To this end, Bakersfield College has collaborated with KHSD to align curriculum and create college placement that credits students for work in high school. BC has redesigned curriculum through the Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT) and the Curriculum Identification numbering processes (C-ID) to guarantee that student work at the college is credited at transfer institutions. This spring BC and CSUB completed the mapping of over 20 ADTs that will allow students to complete a bachelor's degree pathway from BC to CSUB.

The Transfer Taskforce has named this project Finish in 4. Here are 27 pathways that are within the Finish in 4 umbrella.
