II. Agenda

- a. Catalyst RFP
 - KCCD Contracts and Procurement are reviewing all Catalyst proposals for compliance and will release all proposals that pass its process to the Review Committee
 - 46 total applications received. Not all may pass Procurement's threshold review
 - a. Cecilia: Do we have a number of applications by region?
 - b. Rosa: For applications that do not pass the threshold review, will the Governance Council still be able to review those proposals? What does the technical assistance portion look like and when will it be provided? Can we get a list of the 46 proposals now?
 - i. The Review Committee will receive the entire list of 46 total applications.
 - ii. A Conflict of Interest and Non Disclosure forms will need to be signed by all members of the Review Committee

- iii. The list of the proposals will be shared as soon as possible
- c. Alissa: will the Review Committee get to see the proposals for all 46? Will those who did not meet the threshold be eligible for review? How long will the Procurement's review process take?
 - The Review Committee will review proposals who meet Procurement's threshold
 - ii. Proposals that did not meet the threshold will not be moved forward for review; A letter is being drafted to describe additional support that can be provided
 - iii. Procurement review is currently underway, but documents will also need to be translated which may extend this timeline

ii. Confidentiality

- A Conflict of Interest and Non Disclosure forms will need to be signed by all members of the Review Committee – these will be sent along with the list of proposals
 - a. Lori: what is included in the forms? Do we have details on protocols on maintaining confidentiality? We should ask the GC for their preferences on how proposals will be reviewed (structure, format, etc). My preference is to review hard-copies of proposals

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b. Jim: On the distribution of the proposals why not go old school and put all proposals on a thumb drive and mail it out to GC members??

 - ii. Lori: can Procurement release proposals in batches once translations have been done so the Review Committee can get started? Understanding is that technical assistance can be provided for proposals that do not pass the feasibility review
